WRHA Awards Program

- Weekend high point
--Awards will be given in 5 divisions: All Age, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth & All Breed. Must be a current WRHA member and exhibit in at least one cattle class in that division to qualify.
- Year-End Awards
--There are over 100 awards to be given out at year end, see the nomination form for details and how to nominate.
- Make sure to check out the **Versatility challenge** to showcase your horses many talents.

- c) Grade horses CANNOT be registered at the show.
- d) All classes are judged according to ARHA rules.
- e) Negative 12-month coggins required.
- f) Out of state horses: WI requires proof of original health certificate
- g) All youth classes are 18 & under as of January 1, 2019.
