Year End Awards 2019

Exhibitor must be a current year WRHA member and must show at a minimum of three of the five shows to qualify for any of the following awards.

Class Awards - \$5.00 nomination fee per class.

Awards given to 1st, 2nd & 3rd highest point earners in each class. Must earn at least one point in the class to receive award. Class points will be tabulated based on the following table. Points will be awarded based on class placings only (no additional points for grand or reserve).

Final points total will include all points earned in respective class at the 2019 shows.

Completed nomination forms must be submitted and fees paid before earned points from the class begin counting. For example, if you show at the first and second show but did not turn in your form until the morning of the second show, the points earned at the first show will not count towards your year end total.

In the case of a tie, the exhibitor/horse with the highest number of points earned in that class under Judge A at the five Wisconsin-based shows will be the winner.

Division Hi Point and Reserve Hi Point Year End

No nomination fee - Awarded to the all around highest point earners in each division.

All-Age Division

Amateur Division

Youth Division

Novice Amateur Division

All Breed Division

Points earned will be determined using the points schedule shown above. Final points total will include all points earned by the horse in the All-Age Division and by the exhibitor/horse combination in Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth and All Breed divisions at the Wisconsin-based shows - **must have exhibited in at least one cattle class in that division at each of the shows for the points from that show to count towards the respective award.**

In the case of a tie, the exhibitor/horse with the highest number of points earned in that class under Judge A at the shows that were included in the total will be the winner.

Versatility Award

Exhibitor must choose five classes and pay \$5 nomination fee for each class chosen - 2 cattle classes, 2 ARHA classes and 1 conformation class).

Year end high point only.

Offered in All Age and Amateur only.

Tie breaker will be the same as above.
