## General Membership Meeting september 15, 2023 ELKHORN, WI


- 1. Treasurer's Report
- 2. Dates (Goal: All cattle in new outdoor arena)

  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Show: August 10-11 in indoor or October 12-13 in outdoor
    - o Vote was conducted (25 Aug : 4 Oct) 3rd show will be held August 10-11.
  - 4th Show: September 21-22
  - Can not rent out full grounds due to pricing not being cost effective.

#### Grounds

- Discussion about donating to expand cattle warm-up arena.
  - O Dave W. made a motion to talk to Larry about making the cattle warm-up arena (Arena #5) larger with donation from WRHA (If the amount was more than \$10,000.00 additional approval with be required to move forward.). Jo Ellen will see what Larry has to offer in exchange for the donation. After, WRHA will be able to re-evaluate & make a decision. Sarah T. seconded. All in favor.
  - o Jo Ellen to provide update on or before Awards Banquet held in 2024.
- Can we add sand to the arena?
  - It had been discussed with Larry and they will not change the ground for any one club because there are so many different clubs with different footing requirements they will not make any changes for any one club.
