

### WHAT'S NEW?

#### 1. Youth Scholarship Program

WRHA announced at our banquet in February that we would be initiating our Youth Scholarship Program. This program is only open to youth WRHA members who participated in the 2022 or 2023 show season and are a current 2024 member. This program was created for youth that felt they would benefit from individual lessons with a professional trainer. The youth were asked to obtain sponsorship money in which WRHA would match the dollar amount up to \$150 creating a total of \$300 to be used for the youth rider's lessons. A list of WRHA approved trainers across Wisconsin and Northern Illinois were given to youth riders to pick their preferred trainer. This program is limited to the first 15 youth who submit their sponsorship form.

#### 2. Elimination of Working Ranch Horse Classes

The 2024 Board of WRHA unanimously agreed to eliminate the Working Ranch Horse Classes from the 2024 showbill due to low entry numbers.

#### 3. Addition of Green Horse Ranch Riding

A Green Horse Ranch Riding class will be added to the 2024 showbill.

-To be added before Junior Horse Ranch Riding.

#### 4. Addition of Green Horse Trail & Walk/ Trot Restricted Trail

A Green Horse Trail and Green Horse Walk/ Trot Restricted Trail classes will be added to the 2024 showbill.

#### 5. All Cattle Classes Return to Saturday

All cattle classes take place on Saturday as follows: Cutting, Herd Work, Boxing, Ranch Roping, Ranch Cutting, and Working Cow Horse.

#### 6. Sunday Main Arena Line Up

Classes to take place on Saturday are as follows: Conformation, Lead Line, Walk/ Trot, Ranch Riding and Ranch Reining.





#### 7. At- Will Classes Saturday Line Up

Saturday At-Will classes are as follows: Horsemanship, Trail and Reining.

#### 8. At- Will Classes Sunday Line Up

Sunday At-Will classes are as follows: Showmanship and Ranchmanship.






