WRHA Membership of horse owner and all exhibitors is required to exhibit at a WRHA show. Negative 12 month Coggins required and out of state horses will be required to show original health certificate dated within 30 days of show. All youth classes are 18 and under as of January 1, 2024. All classes are judged according to ARHA rules. For detailed rules, see the ARHA rulebook. Judges' decisions are final. WRHA Awards Program – WRHA offers an awards program for exhibitors, refer to the Results/ year end points page – Awards on the WRHA website for more information. Must exhibit in a cattle class to be eligible for a weekend highpoint and Must exhibit at a minimum of three of the four WRHA shows, to qualify for year end awards. No nomination necessary

Green as Grass (GAG) division is for Amateur and Youth exhibitors in their 1<sup>st</sup>,2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> calendar year of showing in any association. Exhibitor is no longer eligible for GAG if they have won a WRHA year end Grand or Reserve high point in GAG or any other division. All horses must be ridden in legal ARHA tack. Horses may be ridden two-handed in GAG s and GREEN horse classes . No training equipment is allowed. Exhibitor must wear proper attire. # Show Fees

In order to qualify for pre-entry fee, entries MUST be received by the show office (via email or online entries) no later than **5pm the Monday** preceding the show.

*Cattle fees:	\$35 per class (must be paid in addition to class entry fee)
Stalls:	\$70 weekend or \$35/Day (no overnight)
Trailer in fee:	\$20/day
Camping:	\$70 weekend or \$35/day (no overnight)
Office Fee:	\$20/per horse
ARHA Fee:	\$18/horse (only applies to horses being shown in ARHA classes) ##
Please Note:	No refunds. A signed check or cash must be on file with the Office before showing. \$25 NSF charge will apply.

WRHA membership is required for horse owners and exhibitors in order to exhibit at any WRHA show.

# ARHA membership is required for Horse owner and exhibitors if exhibiting in any ARHA sanctioned class. Provide copy at time of entry.

**Green as Grass (GAG)** is for Amateur and Youth in their 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> third calendar year of showing in ANY club or association.

**Green Horse (GH)** – The purpose of these classes is to give horses new to the show world an opportunity to compete against horses of similar experience levels. Exhibitor may be a youth, amateur or open rider.
